Matakana Madness will be playing against Te Puna Blue on **Wednesday 6th July** in the semi final.

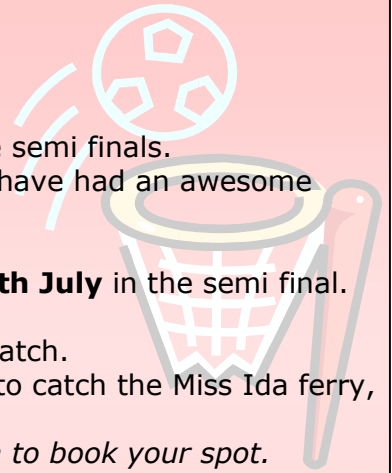
There will be transport for supporters who would like to come along and watch.
